Organizational Information

Organization

The Salt Lake Crit is a 501c3 not for profit.

Eligibility General Categories

All riders must present a current USA Cycling License or a UCI International License. Riders may only race in the category that is shown on their license and age groups as listed in the event Technical Guide.

General Rules

- Race day packet pickup will be at registration for each race venue. Registration is available up to 30-minutes prior to the start of each event.
- Race numbers are not transferable.
- A valid racing license must be shown at packet pickup.
- You may only race in the category for which you have a license or in the appropriate age category. Your appropriate age category is the age you will be as of December 31, 2023.
- All registered riders who did not complete the online waiver, will be required to complete, and sign the USA Cycling Accident Waiver and Release of Liability at packet pickup.
- Riders under the age of 18 will also require the signature of a parent or legal guardian.
- No refunds will be given.
- Two (2) bib numbers will be issued for the Pro Cat 1-2 Men-Women. One (1) bib for all other categories.

Miscellaneous Rules

- Disc brakes are legal under USAC rules.
- All Racers must queue in the designated staging corral 15 min before the start of their race.
- Free lap rule is in effect but ends with a determined number of laps remaining and will be announced at the start line of each race by the Chief Referee for all races on Saturday and Sunday.
- All racers are responsible for knowing the course and following USA Cycling rules.
- Protests and appeals must be made within the time limits established in the USAC Rules.

Medical Services

A fully staffed first aid station and EMSA will be located on each course throughout the weekend. Look for the standard “red cross” flag for the First Aid station.

The Local Hospitals in order of proximity to the race courses are:

- (Saturday): University of Utah Hospital, 50 Medical Dr. N, Salt Lake City
- (Sunday) St Marks Hospital, 1200 E 3900 S, Millcreek
- (Sunday) Intermountain Medical Center, 5121 Cottonwood Street, Murray

Bib Numbers

- Each race packet will contain a set of two (2) race numbers for Pro Cat 1-2 Men-Women, one (1) number for all other categories. Numbers may not be folded or trimmed. You will receive a second number if you are racing in more than one race category.
- Numbers must be worn on the right side for all events and the bottom should be aligned with the side seam of the jersey (vertical orientation).
- If you lose your number, you will be charged a \$10 fee for a replacement numbers.
- Race Numbers are the same for both days.

Finishes, Prizes, and Primes

- After finishing, please do not congregate at the finish line. Be aware of the finish line cameras – do not cross the finish line after the finish.
- Pro Cat 1-2 Men-Women payouts are cash, all other categories are cash-awards-prizes as they apply.
- Pro category payouts will happen the week following the race. Team or rider must submit a w-9 if prize money is \$600 or more.
- YOU MUST SHOW YOUR RACE NUMBER AND RACE LICENSE TO CLAIM PRIZES AND PRIMES.
- Only the racer himself-herself can claim prizes. Racer must provide a legible signature when claiming a prize.
- Saturday and Sunday Event Prizes will be available after each race’s results have been made final at the payout tent at each venue.
- Special attention should be paid to the timeliness of protests and appeals.
- All results will be posted on www.yourresults.live No printed results will be posted onsite.
- If you win over \$600, you must fill out a W-9 form before receiving a payout.

Doping Control

- Anti-doping inspections may be carried out by USADA (United States Anti-Doping Agency). If a rider is requested to be screened, their race number will be posted at the USADA board or USADA personnel will directly inform the racer. It is the responsibility of each racer to check the board and to report to the USADA location. Failure to appear will result in a positive test result. Alternates must also present themselves until released by USADA.

Awards Protocol

Podiums

- The top three Pro Cat 1-2 Men-Women must wear their full team uniform to each awards presentation. The podiums for each criterium will take place 10 min following the finish of the last race, women first followed by the men.
- All other events will also have a podium ceremony. Top three finishers are to be at the podium 15 min following their race. After the next race has started, we will start the podium ceremony.

Heat Protocol

Salt Lake City can be Hot in July, The Event Director in cooperation with the Chief Referee will determine if a water zone will be set up if it is deemed that rider safety would be in jeopardy. The Feed Zone will allow for water hand up based on this decision.

This will apply to the Pro Men and Pro Women's fields only.

Location and if this action be applied will be determine and emailed to the effected riders no later than the morning of the event.

Emergency Medical Services
